



What is an ADRC?

(Aging and Disabilities Resource Center)

A fully functioning ADRC will provide:

- Information and counseling to help people assess their potential need and eligibility for all available long-term support options, both public and private.
- The capacity to link consumers with needed support through appropriate referrals to other programs and benefits and has the ability to track client intake, needs assessment and care plans.
- Established collaborative relationships with programs that provide home and community services including State Health Insurance Programs (SHIP), National Family Caregiver Support Program (NFCSP), Alzheimer's Disease services, health promotion, and disease prevention programs, transportation, employment, housing, adult education and others.
- Follow-up, when needed, to determine outcome of options counseling
- Information that enables people to make informed cost-effective decisions about long term care.
- The process to ensure that people are connected to the appropriate crisis intervention services.
- Assistance to individuals to plan for future long –term care needs.
